Important: All contract work performed by certified MBE/WBE firms must be reported to the Minority Business Enterprise Compliance Office (MBECO) regardless of the specific type of MBE Determination received by the prime vendor for the project (MBE Waiver or MBE Approval). The below referenced contract will not be released until this MBE Utilization Plan has been approved by the MBE Compliance Office.

All MBE forms listed in this form are required documentation and must be submitted for review directly to the Minority Business Enterprise Compliance Office (MBECO) at MBE.Compliance@doa.ri.gov.

MBE-01A	Copies of all Subcontractor Bid solicitations	✓		<p>Copy of the MPA No., RFQ, RFP scopes used for bid solicitation requests that have been sent to all certified and non-certified firms regarding subcontracting opportunities to be submitted to MBECO at MBE.Compliance@doa.ri.gov.</p>
MBE-01B	MBE Good Faith Efforts (GFE)	✓		<p>For ALL Contracts: Vendors must demonstrate <i>good faith efforts</i> in meeting the minimum 15% MBE participation requirement pursuant to RIGL 37-14.1. Vendors may consult the MBE Directory, to review a list of certified firms with applicable North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes for their project.</p> <p>Attach a separate detailed summary, on your firm's letterhead outlining your efforts to obtain MBE participation that are not apparent from the information provided. This is an opportunity for your organization to demonstrate its adequate <i>good faith efforts</i>. Please remember, MBECO will utilize GFE guidance as identified in 220-RICR-80-10-2.8 G4 to make a GFE determination</p> <p>Note: Failure to submit may result in non-compliance determination.</p>

MBE-002	Monthly Project Report	✓		<p>Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 37-14.1 and the regulations promulgated thereto, this form must be submitted to MBECO on a monthly basis for the lifetime of the contract.</p> <p>This report should be utilized to track the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subcontractor Agreements • Reporting changes such as: MBE firms used and Subcontractor award • Project progress including MBE Participation • Subcontractor payments <p>*Vendors must stay within compliance of approved MBE plan.</p>

# of all included Subcontracts	Subcontracts	✓		<p>Prime Vendors are responsible for ensuring reasonable payment terms in all subcontractor agreements made with MBE Subcontractors on projects utilizing state funding. All payment terms included in subcontractor payment agreements must abide by the state's Prompt Payment statute, refer to RIGL 42-11.1.</p> <p>Each Prime Contractor shall make payments to subcontractors within seven (7) days of receipt of payment by the State. Subcontractor agreements must allow subcontractors to submit invoices monthly for work performed. The Prime Contractor must include those subcontractor invoices in its next monthly invoice to the State for work performed under an executed contract. Subcontracting agreements should be provided to MBECO upon receipt of an MBE Determination (Approval or Waiver).</p>
Additional GFE Conditions to Be Performed by Prime Vendors				
MBE-003	Payroll	✓		All subcontractor payments should be accompanied by payroll records for all MBE subcontractors working on the approved project.
MBE-004	Site Visit	✓		<p>MBECO will conduct periodic site visits, otherwise known as On-Site Inspections, scheduled or unscheduled, at any point during the lifetime of the contract. During which, the prime vendor may be required to furnish copies of purchase orders, subcontracts, canceled checks, and other records as needed to substantiate compliance with the approved MBE Utilization Plan.</p> <p>Commercial Useful Function (CUF) Reviews: MBECO may perform CUF Reviews per 49 CFR 26.55(c). MBECO is required to ensure that an MBE has the ability to carry out its responsibilities by actually performing, managing, and supervising the work required by contract; ensuring this work fits within the scope of the MBE Certifications.</p>
MBE-005	Payment Proof	✓		The Prime Vendor is required to furnish payment proof for all payments made to MBEs, such payment proof may include cancelled checks or reports from an accounting software capable of generating accurate and detailed payment reports that include transaction and invoice dates and amounts.
