The undersigned contractor agrees and certifies that it follows the applicable requirements of Federal Executive Order # 11246, as amended Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities, Rhode Island General Law 28-5.1-10, and other regulations as issued by the State Purchasing Agent as set forth below or will take steps to comply with such requirements before accepting any contract from the State of Rhode Island.

Equal Opportunity Clause

- A. Notice to All Contractors

If it should be determined by the Division of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (DEDI) / State Equal Opportunity Office (EOO) that any contractor doing business with the State of Rhode Island is guilty of non-compliance with the provisions of this document, said contractor will be given two written warnings. Failure to comply immediately after the second written notice, the State Equal Opportunity Office will notify the State Purchasing Agent, who shall have the authority to have the contract revoked, and all contractual obligations of the State dealing with the contract in question will be null and void. A signature is required before the successful bidder's award; failure to sign shall cause the bid to be rejected.
